The accompanying tariff sheets issued by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren Missouri or the Company), are being transmitted for filing as a revision of Schedule No. 2, Schedule of Rates for Gas Service:

Filed 8th Revised Sheet No. 78 2nd Revised Sheet No. 83 Canceling 7th Revised Sheet No. 78 1st Revised Sheet No. 83

The tariff sheets are being issued December 9, 2010 to become effective on and after January 8, 2011. However, Ameren Missouri is requesting expedited treatment so tariff sheets can become effective as soon as possible.

The tariff sheets are being filed to reflect changes to the amount of funds used in Ameren Missouri's Missouri Energy Efficient Natural Gas Equipment And Building Shell Measure Rebate Program. The original funding for 2010 was set at \$325,176. Due to a greater than expected participation by Residential customers, the Company, with support of the Residential and Commercial Energy Efficiency Collaborative (RCEEC), is proposing to remove the current funding level limitation by (1) providing \$100,000 in funding from funds already in the Company's natural gas energy efficiency account and (2) providing any additional funds that are necessary for the 2010 program. If additional funds are necessary, the Company will defer that additional amount for future ratemaking treatment in the manner set forth in paragraph 19 in the Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in Case No. GR-2007-0003.
