The procedural schedule in this rate complaint has been indefinitely suspended while the related complaint pending in Case No. GC-2006-0491 proceeds. On April 20, 2007, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order authorizing Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC, to merge with an affiliated company, Missouri Interstate Gas, LLC, to become an interstate pipeline subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the FERC. Because the Commission has not had guidance from the parties regarding the effect of the FERC decision on this case, the Commission will require the parties to offer that guidance.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than June 20, 2007, each party shall file a pleading explaining what effect the April 20, 2007 decision of the FERC to allow Missouri Pipeline Company and Missouri Gas Company to merge with Missouri Interstate Gas has on this case.

2. This order shall become effective on June 6, 2007.
