Dear Mr. Nixon:

As you are aware, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission has just announced that it is opposing AquaSource Utility, Inc.'s ("AquaSource") request to recover the acquisition premium involved in the transfer from Central Jefferson to AquaSource. The Staff also stated that it cannot support the Application for approval of the transfer as filed or with AquaSource's suggested "conditions" for acquisition premium recovery. The Staff is also suggesting that some action be taken to address an alleged overearning situation at Central Jefferson. We find these circumstances to be unacceptable to AquaSource from both a business and regulatory standpoint. We have diligently attempted to convince the Staff that our proposals are meritorious, but our efforts have obviously been unsuccessful.

The position of the Staff has left AquaSource no alternative but to terminate the Stock Purchase Agreement. It is therefore with great regret that I advise you that under Section 8.1(b) of the Stock Purchase Agreement (which allows either party to terminate the Agreement if all of the transactions contemplated to take place at the closing have not been consummated by the last business day of the fourth month after the date of the agreement), AquaSource is exercising its contractual right to terminate the Agreement effective this date.
