On this date Proceeding Commissioner Raul  
moved for the enactment of the following Resolution and Order:

RESOLUTION AND ORDER 6-20-2000 A OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF  
THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, MISSOURI TO FORM A COUNTYWIDE SEWER  
DISTRICT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 249.430 TO 249. 668 RSMO ; ESTABLISH  
BOUNDARIES OF THE SEWER DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE  
DATE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the County Commission of Jefferson County, Missouri, under the authority  
of Sections 249.430 to 249.668<sup>3</sup> of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, has determined  
that it is in the best interest of the County that the delivery of sanitary sewer service to the  
unincorporated areas of the County of Jefferson not presently served by sewer districts is of vital  
importance to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this county; and

WHEREAS, the sewer engineer has made a recommendation with reference to the  
establishment of proper boundaries of the sewer district.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and ordered by the County Commission of the  
County of Jefferson, Missouri as follows:

Section 1: It is deemed by this County Commission that the construction of sanitary  
sewers is necessary for the sanitation, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this county.

Section 2: It is hereby proclaimed that the countywide sewer district shall be known  
as the "Jefferson County Public Sewer District."

Section 3: The description, size and location of the district is generally as follows:

The Jefferson County Public Sewer District generally encompasses the entire area of  
Jefferson County, Missouri, except as follows:

B. All areas that The Missouri Department of Resources has designated a sole regional or watershed supplier of wastewater disposal or treatment services. The areas with a sole regional or watershed supplier of wastewater disposal or treatment services are:

1. Northeast Public Sewer District
  - a. Saline/Sugar Creek Watershed
  - b. Fenton Creek Watershed

- c. Williams Creek Watershed
  - d. Antire Creek Watershed
- 2. Rock Creek Public Sewer District
  - a. Rock Creek Watershed
- 3. Glaize Creek Sewer District
  - a. Glaize Creek Watershed
- 4. Selma Village Sewer District
- 5. Lake Adele Sewer District
- 6. Valle Lake Sewer District

Section 4: The geographic location of the Jefferson County Public Sewer District lies approximately between 90 degrees 15 minutes to 90 degrees 47 minutes west longitude and 38 degrees 0 minutes to 38 degrees 29 minutes north latitude.

Section 5: This Order shall be in full force and in effect from and after the date of its passage. If any part of this order is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not effect the remainder of this order.

Second District Commissioner Casey seconded the motion.

Thereupon, the Presiding Commissioner Samuel J. Rauls called for a vote.

The County Commission voted as follows:
