WHEREAS, the County Commission of Jefferson County, Missouri, under the authority of Sections 249.430 to 249.66° of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, as amended, has determined that it is in the best interest of the County that the delivery of sanitary sewer service to the unincorporated areas of the County of Jefferson not presently served by sewer districts is of vital importance to the health, safety and welfare of the residents of this county; and

WHEREAS, the sewer engineer has made a recommendation with reference to the establishment of proper boundaries of the sewer district.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved and ordered by the County Commission of the County of Jefferson, Missouri as follows:

Section 1: It is deemed by this County Commission that the construction of sanitary sewers is necessary for the sanitation, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this county.

Section 2: It is hereby proclaimed that the countywide sewer district shall be known as the "Jefferson County Public Sewer District."
