2	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. We're here today for a
3	rulemaking hearing in Case Number EX-2012-0193, which
4	concerns Staff's Proposed Amendment to the Commission's Net
5	Metering Rule.
6	We'll begin today, this is just a rulemaking
7	hearing, so we're not going to swear in witnesses and so
8	forth, but Mr. Mills, you indicated you wanted to go first,
9	so I'll let you make your comment.
10	MR. MILLS: I did, thank you, Judge. I've got
11	another prehearing starting at the same time across the hall.
12	I just wanted to get on the record that Public Counsel has no
13	objection to the proposed rule changes. I reviewed the
14	comments of the Staff and Union Electric and I have no
15	objection to the changes that they've proposed and their
16	comments as well.
17	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay.
18	MR. MILLS: Thank you very much.
19	JUDGE WOODRUFF: And I suppose you should
20	identify yourself for the record.
21	MR. MILLS: I'm Lewis Mills, Public Counsel.
22	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Mr. Chairman, any
23	questions of Public Counsel.
24	CHAIRMAN GUNN: None.
25	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. Mills, you may go next

- I'll go ahead with Staff comments at this
- 3 point.
- 4 MS. McCLOWRY: Staff filed their comments in
- 5 this case yesterday and they have no objections to Ameren
- 6 Missouri's comments that were filed yesterday as well. I
- 7 have Lena Mantle and Dave Elliott here if you have any
- 8 questions for them.
- 9 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. Chairman, do you have any
- 10 questions for Staff?
- 11 CHAIRMAN GUNN: No, I do not.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. All right. Then I see
- Ameren Missouri's in the room.
- 14 MS. TATRO: Good morning, Wendy Tatro for
- 15 Ameren Missouri. We filed our comments yesterday. I think
- they're self-explanatory. I do have Wade Miller from our
- 17 regulatory group with me and available to answer any
- 18 questions that the Commissioners might have.
- 19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. Mr. Chairman, any
- 20 questions for Ameren?
- 21 CHAIRMAN GUNN: No questions.
- 22 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Commissioner Jarrett, do you
- have any questions for Ameren?
- 24 COMMISSIONER JARRETT: I do not have any
- 25 questions. Thank you.

- 1 MS. TATRO: Good morning, sir.
- 2 CHAIRMAN GUNN: Did you indicate whether you
- 3 had objected to Staff comments?
- 4 MS. TATRO: I don't think we did. We have no
- 5 objection. I think Staff just kind of has a summary.
- 6 JUDGE WOODRUFF: I wanted to clarify that also
- 7 from Staff. What you filed yesterday was a summary of the
- 8 changes that are already in the rule rather than making new
- 9 changes to the rule; is that correct:
- 10 MS. MANTLE: This is Lena Mantle for the
- 11 Staff. Yes, that is correct. I went through each of the
- 12 changes, offered an explanation for the change. We did have
- 13 two -- when going through it yesterday, came across two
- 14 different spots where I think the language can be more clear
- 15 and that is offered in our comments. That would be what is
- in red. One was to fully identify the co-generation rule is
- in two places, Chapter 20 and Chapter 3. And the other was
- we asked that the company supply some information to Staff
- 19 and that's pretty generic. I narrowed that down to who at
- 20 Staff they should send had a information to so that we can
- 21 make sure the appropriate staff review it.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right.
- MS. MANTLE: So those were our two suggested
- changes to what is being proposed.
- 25 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And Ms. Tatro, you indicated

1	Ameren does not disagree with those changes?
2	MS. TATRO: I believe those changes are
3	appropriate.
4	JUDGE WOODRUFF: And Staff agrees with
5	Ameren's proposed changes?
6	MS. MANTLE: Staff agree.
7	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Is there anyone else in the
8	room who wanted to make a comment? Mr. Chairman, anything
9	you want to add?
10	CHAIRMAN GUNN: No, I love it when everybody
11	agrees. Good job.
12	JUDGE WOODRUFF: Commissioner Jarrett, do you
13	have anything you want to add?
14	COMMISSIONER JARRETT: I don't have anything
15	to add. Thank you very much for being here today.
16	JUDGE WOODRUFF: With that, then, we are
17	adjourned. Thank you.
