4 started. We're here for a public hearing regarding
5 a proposed amendment to 4 CSR 240-18.010, which
6 concerns safety standards for electrical
7 corporations, telecommunication companies and rural
8 electric cooperatives.

9 The purpose of this hearing is to obtain
10 comments from the public about those proposed
11 amendments. And we are in a fairly informal
12 process here. If anyone wants to come forward and
13 make a comment about the -- the proposed amendment,
14 please do so.

15 I'll ask that staff go last so that they
16 have a chance to respond to any comments that are
17 made by member of the public. So I'll just, at
18 this point, ask if anyone wants to make a
19 comment. And I see Mr. Mitten.

20 MR. MITTEN: Judge Woodruff, thank you.
21 My name is Russ Mitten, Brydon, Swearngen &
22 England, 320 East Capitol Avenue, Jefferson City,
23 65102. And I'm here today on behalf Union Electric
24 Company doing business as Ameren Missouri.

25 Ameren Missouri didn't file any comments

1 with respect to this rule, but it did want to go on
2 the record as saying that it supports the proopsed
3 amendments, including the additional change
4 proposed by Staff in its September 29th filing.

5 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Any questions?

6 MR. MITTEN: Thank you.

7 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. Anyone else
8 from the public wishing to make a comment? Turn to
9 Staff. Do you have any -- wish to make any
10 comments?

11 Staff did file a -- a written comment in
12 which it suggested that Commission should reference
13 additional errata that was issued on March 31st of
14 2017. Mr. Chairman, do you have any questions for
15 Staff?

16 CHAIRMAN HALL: I have no questions.
17 Thank you.

18 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Anybody else
19 wishing to comment? All right. Then we are
20 adjourned.
