1. Please provide a copy of all invoices submitted from Mr. Morin to Southern Union in the last 3 years. Please update as invoices are received. 2. Please explain how Southern Union Company accounts for and records in its books and records stock and debt "flotation costs" as defined in Mr. Morin"s rebuttal testimony. Please provide a complete description including accounts where such costs are charged.

Response

1. Copies of Dr. Morin's invoices are attached. Dr. Morin has not been retained by Southern Union Company in the past three years, other than his involvement in this proceeding, 2. Debt "flotation costs" are accounted for as follows: All costs associated with the issuance of long-term debt of the Company are aggregated in Account 181 - Unamortized Debt Expense. The costs that are incurred with the issuance of long-term debt typically include underwriting fees, regulatory costs, legal and accounting expenses. These costs are then amortized over the life of the long-term debt instrument to which they are related. The amortization of debt expense is recorded through Account 428 - Amortization of Debt Discount and Expense. The amortization of debt is typically recovered through rates as part

of the embedded cost rate of the long-term debt, which reflects the coupon rate of the debt as adjusted for the effect of debt issuance costs. Equity "flotation costs" are recorded directly to Account 207 - Premium on Capital Stock, as they serve to reduce the net proceeds received from the sale of such equity. Equity flotation costs have no impact on the Company's

income statement.
