ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 5, 2015, the Staff of the Commission, Laclede Gas Company d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy and Southern Union Company f/d/b/a Missouri Gas Energy filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule for this complaint case. The movants explain they have reached an agreement that will resolve all outstanding issues. They anticipate filing a stipulation and agreement on February 6, to present that agreement to the Commission. The movants ask the Commission to continue to reserve the existing hearing dates of May 18-22, but to suspend the other aspects of the procedural schedule to allow time for the Commission to consider their agreement.

Although the Office of the Public Counsel did not join in the motion to suspend procedural schedule, the motion represents that Public Counsel does not object to the relief sought in the motion.

The Commission finds that the request to suspend the procedural schedule while the stipulation and agreement is considered is appropriate.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. The procedural schedule for this case, except for the reserved hearing dates, is suspended.
3. The reserved hearing dates of May 18-22, 2015, shall remain on the Commission's calendar until further order of the Commission.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
