## ORDER SETTING ASIDE DISMISSAL AND SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Issue Date: May 20, 2015 Effective Date: May 20, 2015

On April 29, 2015, the Commission issued an order dismissing this complaint because Cloris and Ronald Torrey (Complainants) failed to respond to a Commission order directing Complainants to verify whether this complaint had been settled. On May 7, 2015, Complainants filed information showing that a response, as ordered by the Commission, was mailed and received by General Services. However, the pleading was not forwarded to the Commission and entered into the docket.

Because Complainants showed that they responded to the Commission's order, the Commission will set aside its order of dismissal. The Commission will also set this matter for prehearing conference.

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure a resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will

conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; the anticipated length of the hearing; and, the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.

The parties should particularly be prepared to discuss factual and legal disputes and what will be necessary for the Commission to find and conclude.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The order dismissing this complaint, issued on April 29, 2015, is set aside.
- 2. A prehearing conference shall be held on June 1, 2015, at the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 North 7th Street, Suite 105, St. Louis, Missouri from 10:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
