ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 5, 2007,¹ the Commission adopted the procedural schedule in this matter. On June 7, Missouri Gas Energy (“MGE”) filed a motion to amend that schedule requesting the Commission change the date for filing direct testimony from July 2 to July 9. MGE makes its request because of scheduling conflicts and represents that it has contacted all of the parties and that no party objects to the change.

The Commission finds MGE’s request to be reasonable and shall grant its unopposed motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The procedural schedule in this matter is modified to change the date for filing direct testimony from July 2, 2007, to July 9, 2007.
2. The remainder of the procedural schedule adopted on April 5, 2007 remains unchanged.
