**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF AND GRANTING MOTION
FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Issue Date: November 20, 2007

Effective Date: November 26, 2007

On November 6, 2007, the Commission granted Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide gas service in certain portions of Harrison County. On November 7, 2007, MGU filed tariff sheets purporting to comply with the order and also filed a motion requesting an expedited effective date for the tariff.

MGU stated that the service proposed is for a specific customer and the construction of the service lines to that customer is expected to be completed by November 26, 2007. Therefore, MGU requested that the compliance tariff become effective on that date.

The Commission directed that the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission file a recommendation regarding the tariff no later than November 15, 2007. Staff filed its recommendation on November 14, 2007, stating that MGU had complied with the Commission's order and recommending that the tariff be allowed to become effective as

requested. In addition, in Staff's opinion, MGU has shown good cause for the tariff to become effective on less than thirty-days notice. No other party filed a response to the Motion for Expedited Treatment.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved. The Commission has also reviewed the motion for expedited treatment and finds that in order to allow MGU to serve a large industrial customer as soon as possible, good cause exists under Section 393.140(11), RSMo 2000, to expedite the effective date of the tariff. Therefore, the Commission will approve this tariff to become effective on November 26, 2007.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Expedited Treatment filed by Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., on November 7, 2007, is granted.
2. The tariff sheets filed by Missouri Gas Utility, Inc., on November 7, 2007, and assigned tariff number YG-2008-0306, are approved to become effective on November 26, 2007. The tariff sheets approved are:
