The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing its staff ("Staff") to file a recommendation as to the filings of Inter-Tel NetSolutions, Inc., ("Inter-Tel"). Inter-Tel filed a cover letter on April 22, 2009, setting forth its new name. Attached documents include adoption notices and revised tariff title sheets with effective dates of May 22, 2009. The Commission deems the filings to be applications for the recognition of Inter-Tel's name changes for its interexchange (IXC) and competitive local exchange (CLEC) certificates. Therefore, the Commission will order Staff to file its recommendation no later than May 1, 2009.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's staff shall file a recommendation as to the applications no later than May 1, 2009.

¹ Ordinarily, the Commission could assure sufficient time for the preparation of a motion for re-hearing if it issued a decision by Monday, May 11, 2009.
