ORDER APPROVING FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE TRUE-UP

Issue Date: August 27, 2014

Effective Date: August 29, 2014

On June 30, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (“GMO”) filed an application containing its eleventh Fuel Adjustment Clause (“FAC”) true-up, identifying the amounts of over or under-recovery for its most recently completed twelve-month recovery period.¹

The Commission’s rule regarding fuel adjustment clauses requires the Commission’s Staff to examine and analyze the information submitted by GMO and to submit a recommendation within 30 days.² Staff filed its recommendation on July 25, 2014. Based on its examination and analysis of information filed by GMO, including the direct testimony of GMO’s witness Linda Nunn, and supporting schedules, Staff recommends the Commission approve GMO’s true-up filing amounts of \$60,894 under-recovery from customers in its MPS rate district and over-recovery of \$94,476 from customers in its L&P

rate district.³ Staff further explains that the under-collected amount for the MPS rate district and the over-recovered amount for the L&P rate district, including accumulated interest, are included in GMO's proposed changes to its current period fuel adjustment rates in its semi-annual FAC filing in File No. ER-2014-0373, currently before the Commission.

More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its recommendation, and no party has filed a response to that recommendation.⁴

Based on the Direct Testimony of Linda Nunn, submitted by GMO along with its application, as well as the uncontested recommendation of Staff, the Commission will approve GMO's true-up filing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's true-up filing for the eleventh recovery period (March 1, 2013, through February 28, 2014) is approved.
2. This order shall become effective on August 29, 2014.
3. This file shall be closed on September 2, 2014.
