## ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION AND PERMITTING COMMENT FROM INTERESTED PERSONS

The Commission is considering a ten-month schedule for resolving this action and has invited comment on that matter from the parties to this action in writing and at the Commission's March 2, 2016 agenda.<sup>1</sup> The Commission also directed notice of that matter to each party in the most recent general rate case of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company.<sup>2</sup> Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG") filed a *Motion for Reconsideration* seeking reconsideration of the March 2, 2016 agenda *Order Directing Filing*.<sup>3</sup> The Commission will deny that motion and maintain the matter on its March 2, 2016 agenda. But the Commission will also consider comments from interested persons who are not currently parties to this action presented at the March 2, 2016, agenda or filed as set forth in the ordered paragraphs below.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion for Reconsideration* is denied.
2. Any interested person may file a response to the *Order Directing Filing*, described in the body of this order, no later than March 1, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.
