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## Q. IF THE COMMISSION ACCEPTS YOUR PROPOSED REVISIONS WHAT LEVEL OF FUNDING WOULD YOU SUGGEST?

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A. The MGE program was funded through a charge of about \$.08 per month per customer. Assuming 5% administrative costs, \$0 evaluation cost and the multi-tier proposed discounts I provided in Attachment 3, I believe the program would allow up to about 125 participants and cost around \$44,200.
