For nearly eight, (8), years, the Big Island water and sewer utility, has been operating under the jurisdiction of the DNR. Therefore Complainants are confident that DNR representatives will provide exclusive testimony in this case regarding the construction and expansion, operation and management of this utility, and its applications, permits, and Notices of Violation, issued by DNR.

The DNR has been made an integral party to this case before the Missouri Public Service Commission, in meetings scheduled throughout these proceedings by formal Complainants, as a means of full disclosure of information to the Department regarding its involvement and participation in the utility issues presented to the PSC.
