**ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO STAFF'S  
RECOMMENDATION TO REJECT COMPLIANCE TARIFF**

On April 29, 2015, the Commission issued a report and order that rejected Ameren Missouri's tariff to increase the company's annual revenues from its provision of electric service. However, the Commission authorized Ameren Missouri to file a tariff sufficient to recover revenues as determined in that report and order. Ameren Missouri filed its compliance tariff on May 6. The next day, on May 7, Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to reject that tariff because, according to Staff, the tariff sheet that implements a reduced rate for the IAS rate class does not comply with the terms of the report and order.

The Commission will order Ameren Missouri to file an expedited response to Staff's recommendation, and will establish a date by which other interested parties may file a response.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Ameren Missouri shall file a response to Staff's recommendation to reject the compliance tariff no later than 1:00 p.m. on May 12, 2015.

2. Any other party wishing to file a response to Staff's recommendation to reject the compliance tariff shall do so no later than 1:00 p.m. on May 12, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
