## ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES

On October 9, 2014, the Commission's Staff filed a petition in File No. EU-2015-0094, seeking an order directing Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") to record a regulatory liability on account of an allowance for fees KCP&L is no longer paying related to spent nuclear fuel storage. On October 30, 2014, KCP&L submitted a tariff designed to implement a general rate increase for electric utility service in File No. ER-2014-0370. On January 19, 2015, the Staff of the Commission and KCP&L filed a *Joint Motion to Consolidate Cases*, which states that the two cases involve related questions of law and fact and requests that the Commission consolidate the two. Ten days have elapsed and no party has objected to the motion. The Commission finds that these actions involve related questions of law and fact and will consolidate these actions pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3).

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. File Nos. ER-2014-0370 and EU-2015-0094 are consolidated. All future case submissions shall be made in File No. ER-2014-0370.
  - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
