ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ACKNOWLEDGING AUTOMATIC PARTIES, AND ESTABLISHING INTERVENTION DATE

On December 30, 2014, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") submitted a tariff to implement an adjustment to its Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC"). The submitted tariff sheet bears an effective date of March 1, 2015.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(4), the Commission's Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed adjustment no later than thirty (30) days after the filing. No later than sixty (60) days after GMO's filing, the Commission must: (1) enter an interim rate adjustment; (2) approve or reject the tariff as submitted; or (3) allow the tariff to go into effect by operation of law. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10)(A) provides that a party or entity granted intervention in the general rate proceeding in which the FAC is approved is automatically a party to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges the parties to File No. ER-2012-0175 are parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. The Commission will also establish a submission date for any other entity that may wish to apply to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties from File No. ER-2012-0175 to the service list for this case.

2. Any proper person or entity wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than January 10, 2015, in the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System ("EFIS").

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation no later than January

29, 2015.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
