ORDER SETTING A DEADLINE FOR OBJECTIONS

On October 28, 2021, the Regulatory Law Judge sent an email to the parties asking if an evidentiary hearing was necessary or whether this case could be decided based on a stipulation of facts and briefs. Evergy Missouri Metro, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Midwest Energy Consumers Group all indicated they were amenable to resolving this case through a stipulation of facts and briefs. This case also has parties that are automatic parties because of their prior participation in File No. ER-2018-0145 (the file in which Evergy Metro's¹ FAC was most recently re-approved). Accordingly, the Commission will set a deadline for any objections to determining this case based on a stipulation of facts and briefs.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party objecting to the Commission determining this case based upon a joint stipulation of facts and briefs shall file that objection no later than November 8, 2021.
