ORDER APPROVING RESRAM TARIFF

Issue Date: January 5, 2022

Effective Date: February 1, 2022

On September 29, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted a proposed tariff sheet and accompanying testimony to adjust its renewable energy standard rate adjustment mechanism (RESRAM) pursuant to Section 393.1030, RSMo, and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(6). The proposed tariff sheet bears an effective date of February 1, 2022. The Commission directed notice, set an intervention deadline, and ordered its Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation. No persons or entities applied to intervene.

Staff filed its recommendation on November 29, 2021. Ameren Missouri's total RESRAM expense balance as of July 31, 2019, including interest, was (\$15,217,049),¹ which includes (\$28,429,490) of Production Tax Credit authorized under Section 45 of the U.S. tax code. The annual RESRAM Revenue Requirement going forward is (\$16,660,719), a true-up amount of \$9,630 and an over recovery of RESRAM expenses of \$15,217,049. Total RESRAM Recoveries are \$31,868,138. Customers using 1,000 kWh per month will see a \$1.04 billing credit, a \$1.21 per month decrease

compared to the previous RESRAM rate. Application of this rate will not exceed the annual rate cap pursuant to Section 393.1655 RSMo. Staff recommends that the Commission approve Ameren Missouri's proposed RESRAM adjustment tariff sheet to be effective on February 1, 2022. The Commission received no responses to Staff's recommendation.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariff sheet and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff sheet conforms to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.100(6). The Commission concludes that the proposed RESRAM adjustment tariff sheet should be approved to become effective on February 1, 2022.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following proposed tariff sheet filed on September 29, 2021, by Ameren Missouri, assigned tracking no. YE-2022-0063 and bearing an effective date of February 1, 2022, is approved to be effective on February 1, 2022:
