**NOTICE THAT TARIFF SHEET WILL GO INTO EFFECT BY
OPERATION OF LAW**

Issue Date: March 24, 2022

On January 31, 2022, Evergy Missouri Metro, Inc. (Evergy Metro) submitted direct testimony and a tariff sheet designed to implement an adjustment to its Fuel and Purchased Power Adjustment Clause (FAC). The Commission directed its Staff (Staff) to file a recommendation about Evergy Metro's FAC filing. On March 2, 2022, Staff recommended that the Commission reject Evergy Metro's FAC tariff revision, Tariff No. JE-2022-0216. No responses to Staff's recommendation were received.¹

On March 9, 2022, in File No. ER-2022-0025, the Commission determined that Evergy Metro could not exclude off-system sales revenue from the February 2021 cold weather event known as Winter Storm Uri from passing through its FAC under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8)(A)2.A.(XI).² Evergy Metro was ordered to file an FAC adjustment tariff compliant with that order.

Staff's March 2, 2022, recommendation states that its position in this case is the same as its position in File No.ER-2022-0025. Evergy Metro's tariff sheet, Tariff No. JE-2022-0206(as originally filed January 31, 2022, and substituted February 17, 2022) also excluded off-system sales revenue related to Winter Storm Uri.

On March 23, 2022, Evergy Metro substituted Tariff No. JE-2022-0206 again to include the Winter Storm Uri revenues in compliance with the order issued in File No. ER-2022-0025. Evergy Metro's cover letter states:

“The Company has included all extraordinary net revenues through December 31, 2021 resulting from Winter Storm Uri as a prior period correction within the “True-Up Amount (T)” line on the proposed tariff sheet. The Company has calculated additional interest through December 2021 on the monthly balances. The calculation is detailed in the updated Section 8 workpapers. Additionally, the PISA workpapers have been updated; however, there is no PISA impact. Lastly, the Company has provided the updated workpapers for review and comment to both Staff and Office of Public Counsel (“OPC”) in advance of this substitute filing and both parties have indicated their approval to proceed with this filing.”

Under the proposed FAC tariff sheet, as substituted March 23, 2022, residential customers would receive a credit of (\$0.00366).³ A residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month would see a credit of (\$3.66). This represents a decrease of \$3.25 for a residential customer's monthly bill compared to the previously approved FAC adjustment.

The Commission has reviewed Evergy Metro's March 23, 2022, substituted tariff filing and finds that the tariff sheet implementing the FAC rate adjustment is in compliance with the Commission's Order establishing the FAC, with all applicable statutes and regulations, and the Commission's order issued in File No. ER-2022-0025.
