Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff on August 1, 2022, to increase its rates for electric service. The Consumers Council of Missouri (Consumers Council) filed an application to intervene on August 9, 2022. More than ten days have passed since Consumers Council applied to intervene and no party has responded to that application.¹

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing Consumers Council to participate in this rate case will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Application to Intervene of Consumers Council is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
