**ORDER APPROVING RIDER ENERGY
EFFICIENCY INVESTMENT CHARGE TARIFF SHEET**

Issue Date: January 19, 2023

Effective Date: February 1, 2023

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed a tariff sheet to adjust the rate of its Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA") Rider, Energy Efficiency Investment Charge ("EEIC Rider"). The terms of EEIC Rider require a filing at least once per calendar year to be effective with the subsequent calendar year's February billing month. Ameren Missouri's annual filing to adjust its EEIC Rider bears an effective date of February 1, 2023.

Ameren Missouri's proposed EEIC Rider adjustment increases rates by approximately \$9.9 million, with specific rate classes being impacted differently. The Residential Service rate will decrease by \$0.09 per month per 1,000kWh, resulting in a residential customer, using 1,000 kWh having a total EEIC charge of approximately \$3.67 per month or \$43.98 annually. The Small General Service rate will increase by \$0.04 per month per 1,000 kWh; the Large General Service rate will increase by \$1.31 per month per 1,000 kWh; the Small Primary Service rate will increase by \$0.79 per month per 1,000 kWh; and the Large Primary Service rate will increase by \$0.87 per month per 1,000 kWh.

The Commission issued notice of the filing and directed the Commission's Staff to submit a recommendation. Staff's Tariff/Rate Design Unit reviewed the tariff sheet,

supporting work papers, and worksheets showing Ameren Missouri's calculations of the proposed rates for the EEIC Rider and projected costs and throughput disincentive for MEEIA Cycle 2 components. Staff also verified that Ameren Missouri is not delinquent with any required filings, including its Quarterly Surveillance Monitoring reports. Staff recommended the Commission approve Ameren Missouri's EEIC Rider tariff sheet. No other responses were filed.

Having reviewed Staff's recommendation, the Commission will approve the proposed tariff sheet. Since the EEIC Rider is unopposed and Ameren Missouri seeks to have the revised tariff sheet go into effect at the start of the February billing month, the Commission finds good cause exists to allow this order to go into effect in less than thirty days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet, assigned JE-2023-0097, is approved to become effective on February 1, 2023:
