ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it shall bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, a copy for the Presiding Judge, and all parties.

(F) A hearing is contemplated on March 3, 2006, beginning at 9:00 a.m., at the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 N. 7th, St. Louis, Missouri. The date, time and room number will be confirmed by separate order.
