ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO MOTION
TO COMPEL DISCOVERY AND TO LIMIT EVIDENCE

On December 1, 2006, USW Local 11-6 filed a motion to compel Laclede Gas Company to respond to certain data requests. It also asks the Commission to preclude Laclede from offering certain evidence at the hearing if it fails to provide the information sought in those data requests. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than ten days to respond to a motion unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Because the hearing is fast approaching, the Commission will shorten the time for response to the union's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to USW Local 11-6's Motion to Compel Discovery and to Limit Evidence shall do so no later than December 5, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on December 4, 2006.
