ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND TO MOTION
TO COMPLY WITH PROTECTIVE ORDER

On Friday, November 3, 2006, the Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to order the Respondents, Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC, and Missouri Gas Company, LLC, to comply with the provision of the Commission's protective order that requires a party asserting that information contained in testimony should be protected from public disclosure to make a filing specifying the nature of the information to be protected and the harm that will result from the disclosure of that information.

The Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri asks for expedited treatment of its motion and requests that the Commission order the Respondents to respond to its motion by the close of the day on Monday, November 6. The Commission agrees that a prompt

response to the Municipal Gas Commission's motion is appropriate, but will allow the other parties until November 7 to respond.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party that wants to respond to the Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri's motion to require the Respondents to comply with the protective order shall do so no later than November 7, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on November 6, 2006.
