ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On June 21, 2006, the Staff of the Public Service Commission filed a complaint against Missouri Pipeline Company, LLC and Missouri Gas Company, LLC. On June 26, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a timely application to intervene. The Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri filed a timely application to intervene on June 28. More than ten days have passed since the applications to intervene were filed and no party has objected to either application.

The Commission finds that AmerenUE and the Municipal Gas Commission have interests that are different than those of the general public. The Commission also finds that that their interests may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing AmerenUE and the Municipal Gas

Commission to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's Application to Intervene is granted.
2. The Municipal Gas Commission of Missouri's Application to Intervene is granted.
3. This order shall become effective on July 13, 2006.
