STAFF'S REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION

1. In the Commission’s discussion of Count V, on page 46 of the August 27 Report and Order, the Commission notes that MGC violated its tariffs by failing to demand reimbursement for the lateral line from the shipper. Further the Commission notes “MGC’s tariff requires the shipper to reimburse MGC for those costs and MGC apparently has not attempted to collect that reimbursement . . . Therefore, MGC has violated its tariff.”

3. This seems to conflict with the Commission's finding that MGC has, in fact, violated its tariff by constructing the lateral line and not seeking reimbursement.

While this violation may not have cost customers anything to date, it discriminated against other marketers who were required to pay for laterals built from the MGC line.

4. Staff respectfully requests the Commission alter its Ordered paragraphs to reflect the fact that, as alleged, MGC violated its tariffs.
