ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE AND FILE A REPORT

Issue Date: December 7, 2006 Effective Date: December 7, 2006

Gale Carpenter filed a formal complaint against Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE") on December 4, 2006. On December 7, 2006, the Commission notified MGE of the complaint and allowed it thirty days in which to answer as provided by 4 CSR 240-2.070(7).

The Commission would like to have the benefit of an investigation and report by its Staff before it further considers this matter.² As this matter does not involve the interruption or discontinuation of Ms. Carpenter's residential gas service or any other time-sensitive issue and also does not appear to involve complex factual or legal issues, Staff should be

able to complete its investigation and prepare a report concerning the results of that investigation no later than two weeks after MGE files its answer, which is due no later than January 8, 2007.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall promptly commence an investigation of Gale Carpenter's formal complaint against Missouri Gas Energy.
- 2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report concerning the results of its investigation no later than two weeks after Missouri Gas Energy files its answer to Gale Carpenter's complaint.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on December 7, 2006.
