PRIVATE ORNAMENTAL STREET LIGHTING RATES
RATE OF LIMITED APPLICATION

1. Rate Application. Available to customers for the lighting of private streets or parkways in the City of St. Louis and in the Urban Service Area of St. Louis County by not less than 5 lamps, having an aggregate rating of not less than 10,000 Lumens, mounted on ornamental columns.
2. Character of Service Supplied. Service supplied hereunder shall be by series incandescent lamps supplied by overhead circuit. Where Customer elects to have service supplied by underground circuit, additional monthly charges shall be made as shown on Sheet No. 55(M).
3. Determination of Applicable Rate.

Schedule "A" shall apply to service delivered during an initial ten year contract term.

Schedule "B" shall apply to (a) service delivered during any contract term to installations served under Schedule "A" during the immediately preceding contract term, and (b) service delivered during the initial term of a twenty year contract entered into prior to September 16, 1954.

Schedule "C" shall apply to service delivered during any contract term to installations served under Schedule "B" or Schedule "C" during the immediately preceding contract term.

4. Contract Renewals. Customer shall have the right to renew a contract for successive periods of ten years each, but until such renewal contract has been signed, the schedule of rates theretofore applicable to the service shall continue.

5. Larger lamps. At any time during any contract term, Customer may, upon written request, obtain the replacement by larger lamps of any or all lamps then being served under the existing contract, in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

- a. If the lamp replacement does not require a change in existing standards or fixtures, such replacement shall be made without cost to Customer, and Customer shall, from the date of such replacement, be billed for service thereto at the rate applicable to the larger lamps under the schedule applicable to the replaced smaller lamps.
- b. If the lamp replacement requires or Customer requests a change in existing standards or fixtures, Customer shall pay in advance, without right of refund, Company's estimated cost of making such changes, and Customer shall, from the date of such replacement, be billed for service thereto at the rate applicable to the larger lamps under the schedule applicable to the replaced smaller lamps.

6. General Provisions.

- a. Company will submit to Customer cuts of standards or fixtures available for installation under this service classification, and Customer may select from these the type to be installed. Ornamental service hereunder provides for the installation on ornamental columns of lamps on brackets, canopies or similar mountings.
- b. All standards, brackets, fixtures, lamps, wires, cables, conduits, and other necessary equipment furnished, owned, installed and maintained by Company, will remain the property of Company, and may be removed by Company if service is discontinued.

6. General Provisions - (Cont'd)

- c. Company will control the turning on and turning off of the street lighting service to provide approximately 4,000 burning hours per year.
- d. Customer shall furnish to Company, without cost to Company and on forms suitable to it, or Customer shall reimburse Company for all costs incurred in obtaining all rights, permits and easements necessary to permit the installation and maintenance of Company's facilities on, over, under and across both public and private property where and as needed by Company in providing service hereunder.
- e. To protect Company against losses due to non-payment of bills by Customer, Company may require surety from Customer in the form of a cash deposit which may equal Company's estimated cost of installing and removing its facilities plus sixty days' revenue in the case of an initial contract, or one year's revenue in the case of a renewal contract.

Interest at the rate of 6% per annum, payable annually or upon return of the deposit, covering the time of the deposit, will be paid by Company to Customer upon every cash deposit so required.

Company will refund to Customer the amount of deposit plus accrued interest, or any balance thereof not applied to delinquent bills, at the expiration of the contract period, or prior thereto, if Company so elects.

If bills for service are not paid within twenty days from date of bill, Company shall have the right to disconnect service and remove its equipment, and in such event any deposit made by Customer shall be forfeited and retained by Company.
