**ORDERED RESPONSE TO PROPOSED TARIFF**

COMES NOW Ag Processing Inc a Cooperative (AGP) and for its Response to the Proposed Tariff states:

1. On March 7, 2012 the Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter, effective April 6, 2012.

2. On March 9, 2012, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed a series of tariff sheets with a proposed effective date of June 25, 2012. Subsequently the Commission directed the parties to submit responses regarding that proposed tariff.

3. Given that the Commission's Report and Order is not effective until April 6, 2012, it would be inappropriate and possibly unlawful in itself for the Commission to approve the proposed tariffs prior to the effective date of the Report and Order and, among other things, consideration of any potential applications for rehearing in the matter.

4. AGP intends to submit a timely application for rehearing.
