3	started then. My name is Morris Woodruff. I am the
4	chief regulatory law judge for the Public Service
5	Commission and I'll be presiding at this local public
6	hearing this afternoon. You've already had an
7	opportunity to ask questions of the parties about
8	this rate case. And this portion of the hearing is
9	now intended to allow for the members of the public
10	to make statements to the Commission about the case,
11	basically to tell us what you want us to hear.
12	First of all this is Case
13	No. GR-2021-0241 which concerns Ameren Missouri's
14	request for increase in its natural gas rates. This
15	hearing is being recorded and transcribed by a court
16	reporter and the transcript will become part of the
17	file and will be reviewed by all the commissioners.

20	We have two commissioners on the line
