**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE**

On January 12, 2006, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed tariff sheets designed to modify its Missouri Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Incentive Grant Program. AmerenUE states that the modified tariff sheets would extend the effective date of and increase funds for the LEED Incentive Grant Program. The LEED Incentive Grant Program was developed pursuant to a Commission order in Case No. EC-2002-1, whereby a collaborative committee was to be established for Residential and Commercial Energy Efficiency programs. The tariff bears an effective date of February 12, 2007. On January 18, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered its Staff to file its recommendation concerning the proposed tariff sheets on or before January 30, 2007.

The Commission finds that notice of the tariff filing shall be given to the parties to Case No. EC-2002-1. The Commission will set a time for interventions and for any responses to Staff's recommendation.

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on all parties to Case No. EC-2002-1.
