**APPLICATION OF FRANCE TELECOM CORPORATE SOLUTIONS, L.L.C.
FOR APPROVAL OF INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT WITH SOUTHWESTERN
BELL TELEPHONE, L.P. d/b/a AT&T MISSOURI**

COMES NOW France Telecom Corporate Solutions, L.L.C. ("FTCS" or "Applicant") and hereby applies for approval by the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the attached Interconnection Agreement and entered into by FTCS and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T"), pursuant to the Federal Telecommunications Act ("Act") under 47 U.S.C. § 252.

1. Applicant's legal name is France Telecom Corporate Solutions, L.L.C. and it is a wholly owned subsidiary of France Telecom S.A. Applicant provides local and interexchange telephone services. FTCS is a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware. Its principal place of business is Mailstop 1100, 13775 McLearen Road, Oak Hill, VA 20171.

2. FTCS is authorized to do business in the State of Missouri, and a Certificate of Good Standing – Foreign Corporation from the Missouri Secretary of State was attached to the Application filed in Commission Case No. LA-2005-0193, and is incorporated herein by reference. FTCS obtained Commission authority to provide interexchange and competitive local exchange services in Missouri on July 15, 2005 (Case No. LA-2005-0193).

3. AT&T is a “local exchange telecommunications company” and a “public utility,” and is duly authorized to provide “telecommunications service” within the State of Missouri as each of those phrases are defined in Section 386.020, RSMo 2000. AT&T’s principal Missouri office is located at One Bell Center, 35th Floor, St. Louis, Missouri 63101.

4. FTCS has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years from the date of the Application. FTCS does not have any overdue annual reports or fees owed to the Missouri Public Service Commission. In support of this Application, FTCS states the following:

I. INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT REACHED

FTCS presents to this Commission for approval a new Interconnection Agreement that was negotiated and executed pursuant to the terms of the Act. The Parties executed the Agreement on January 4, 2007, and hereby file the Agreement, together with Appendices

incorporated herein. There are no outstanding issues between FTCS and AT&T that need the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

FTCS seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Act. FTCS believes that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity, and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes interconnectivity and diversity in providers, and will increase customer choices for telecommunications services.

FTCS respectfully requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation. This bilateral agreement, reached as a result of negotiation and compromise between FTCS and AT&T.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standards of review are set forth in Section 252(e) of the Act which provides:

(e) APPROVAL BY STATE COMMISSION

(1) APPROVAL REQUIRED – Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings to any deficiencies.

(2) GROUNDS FOR REJECTION – The State commission may only reject-

(A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that –


- (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not party to the agreement; or
- (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity;....

IV. MISSOURI LEGISLATION

The negotiated and executed Agreement is consistent with Missouri Senate Bill 507, which became effective on August 28, 1996.

WHEREFORE, France Telecom Corporate Solutions, L.L.C. respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order approving its Interconnection Agreement.


