Section (1) I myron Lockhart is requesting relief from Wacleda gas company And Union Electric Company (dba) Ameron OF current Value. For cashing out Bonds, Shares, stock, and Trust registration, Before the maturity Dates. Which the beneficiary were not payed dividense. And the changed of ownership of Companies.

Section (10) The commission may order, at any time after the filing of a Complaint, an Investigation by its staff as to the Cause of the Complaint. The staff shall file a report of its finding with the Commissions and all the parties to the Complaint case. The investigative report shall not be made Public released in accordance with Sections 386, 480, 392, 210(2) or 393, 140(3), Rsmo, or during the course of the hearing involving the Complaint

Union Electric included a five-year call restriction in its bond indentures since 1963.

The commission shall not be required to dismiss any Complaint because of the Absence of direct damage to the Complainant

4 CSR 240.2.010 Definitions

- (6) Complainant means the Commission, any Person, Corporation, Municipality, Political Subdivision, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Commission staff through the general Counsel, or public utility who files a complaint with the Commission,
- (7) Corporation includes a Corporation, Company, association, or joint stock Company or association; or any other entity created by statute which is allowed to conduct business in the state of Missouri;
- (16) Public Counsel means the Office of the Public Counsel as Created by the Omnibus State Reorganization Act of 1974, and include the Assistants, who represent the Public before the Commission
- (18.) Public utility includes every pipeline Corporation, gas Corporation, electrical Corporation, telecommunications Corporation, Water Corporation, heat or refrigeration Corporation, Sewer Corporation, any joint municipal utility commission Pursuant to Section 386.020, RSMo which is Regulated by the Commission, or any other entity described by the Statute as a public utility which is to be regulated by the Commission.
- (19) Respondent means any Person as defined herein or Public utility subject to regulation by the Commission against whom any complaint is filed.
- (20) Rule means all of these rules as a whole or the individual rule in which the word appears. whichever interpretation is consistent with the rational Application of this Chapter.
