The Missouri Propane Gas Association ("MPGA") asked to file an amended complaint. The Commission's regulations provide:

The Commission received responses from Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNGMO")<sup>3</sup> and Staff.<sup>4</sup> No party objects to the filing of the amended complaint.<sup>5</sup> The Commission will grant leave to file the amended complaint.

SNGMo also filed a request for mediation.<sup>6</sup> The Commission received responses from Staff<sup>7</sup> and MPGA.<sup>8</sup> MPGA consents to mediation and Staff does not oppose the request. The Commission will grant the request and appoint a mediator by separate order.

The Commission's order suspending the schedule<sup>9</sup> shall remain in effect pending the outcome of the mediation.

- 1. The Motion for Leave to File a First Amended Complaint is granted and the First Amended Complaint is filed this date.
- 2. The request for mediation is granted and the procedural schedule as set forth by regulation and order remains suspended.
