ORDER SUSPENDING SCHEDULE AND DIRECTING FILING

Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. (“SNGMO”) asks¹ the Commission to refer this case to mediation and, pending a ruling on that request, to suspend the procedural schedule so that no answer to the complaint—or amended complaint,² if the Commission grants that filing—is due. The Commission will grant that request and direct the other parties to file a response to the request for mediation. The Commission will also reserve ruling on the motion to file an amended complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule as set forth by regulation and order is suspended.
2. Each party other than Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. shall file a response to the request for mediation. The response shall be filed no later than November 16, 2015.

Any response may include procedural suggestions for mediation.
