# ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

Malcom Henry Montgomery, on behalf of Montgomery & Greaser (Complainant) filed a complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren) on December 12, 2016. The complaint was the result of a disputed charge on the Complainant's November 15, 2016 billing statement. Ameren filed its Answer and Affirmative Defense on January 12, 2017, indicating that it had followed its tariffed procedures. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) investigated the matter and filed its report indicating that it did not find any tariff or Commission rule violations and suggesting that the Commission set a conference where the parties could further attempt to settle this matter.

The Commission will set a procedural conference so that the parties can further discuss settlement or a procedural schedule for this case.
