# SECOND ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

Malcom Henry Montgomery, on behalf of Montgomery & Greaser (Complainant) filed a complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri (Ameren) on December 12, 2016. The complaint was the result of a disputed charge on the Complainant's November 15, 2016 billing statement. Ameren filed its Answer and Affirmative Defense on January 12, 2017, indicating that it had followed its tariffed procedures.
