The City of Kansas City submits its position on the following issue(s):

#### Issue:

Should an amount for low income weatherization assistance programs be included in Aquila Networks-MPS's and Aquila Networks-L&P's cost of service. Is so, what amount should be included, how should it be funded, which programs should be included, and what kind of review should be ordered by the Commission?

#### Position:

In concert with the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the City of Kansas City submits that weatherization is a cost-effective way to help low-income families pay their energy bills year after year, reduces state and federal assistance needed to pay higher utility bills, reduces arrearages and helps reduce environmental pollution. The weatherization program implemented by Aquila pursuant to the Unanimous Stipulation in Case Number ER-2004-0034 is highly worthwhile and should be continued albeit at greater funding levels. The City also supports further joint evaluation of this program by Staff, the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Public Counsel, Aquila and the City.

Kansas City takes no position on any of the other issues on the Proposed List of Issues.
