Observation/Findings One amount of wood shingles & metal roof observed. Found some partially buried shingles - a color type on the site.

Conclusion/Recommendations Recommended that Mr. Miller fill out a "Statement of Closure" and submit to the department, after Dept. approach have the dump recorded on the property deed. Or Mr. Miller can remove the material and properly dispose of it at a permit landfill operation.
11-2-01 - Phone call from Mr. David Lees. Stated that he was concerned that they could sit very shingles. Mr. Lees stated he will be out of the state for the next two weeks but will have them removed the week of Thanksgiving.
