On September 5, 2006, the Commission issued an order on its own motion dismissing Wal-Mart Stores East, L.P., as a party to this case because Wal-Mart's application to intervene was filed after the established deadline for the filing of intervention requests, without good cause for the late filing. The Commission had previously granted Wal-Mart's request to intervene in an order issued on July 17. The order dismissing Wal-Mart as a party was given an effective date of September 15.

On September 8, Wal-Mart filed a motion asking the Commission to reconsider the order dismissing it from the case. The Commission is persuaded by Wal-Mart's motion and will grant reconsideration. On reconsideration, the Commission will withdraw its September 5 order. Because that order never went into effect, Wal-Mart may remain as a party to this case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission's Order Dismissing Wal-Mart Stores East, L.P., issued on September 5, 2006, effective September 15, 2006, is withdrawn and shall not go into effect.

2. This order shall become effective on September 14, 2006.
