The Commission's Order Adopting Procedural Schedule issued March 29, 2006, set October 6, 2006, as the filing date for surrebuttal testimony. On October 4, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion requesting an extension of time, until October 10, 2006, to file the surrebuttal testimony of its witness, Ralph C. Smith. Public Counsel related that Mr. Smith is out of state until the evening of October 6 and is thus unable to meet the established deadline. Public Counsel stated that it contacted most of the parties involved in this case and that neither Kansas City Power & Light Company nor any of the other parties contacted objected to its request.
