ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On June 29, 2006, Lynne Shewmaker filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company. According to the complaint, Ms. Shewmaker is not responsible for arrearages on her bill because Laclede's automated meter reading (AMR) unit is miscalibrated. Laclede denies her allegations.

Staff filed a report on September 8 that stated that Ms. Shewmaker is responsible for the bill. Ms. Shewmaker responded on September 15, again asserting that she does not owe the disputed \$969.29.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing.

Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. A prehearing conference shall be held on September 26, 2006, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 2. Any party wishing to appear by telephone shall notify the Regulatory Law Judge by calling 573-751-7497 no later than 5:00 p.m., September 22, 2005.
- 3. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 3, 2006.
 - 4. This order shall become effective on September 18, 2006.
