NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

Issue Date: October 21, 2008

On August 29, 2008, Darlene Weeden filed a complaint against Laclede Gas Company. Ms. Weeden alleged that Laclede overbilled her for gas usage.

On October 20, 2008, Laclede filed a Notice of Dismissal on behalf of Ms. Weeden in response to a Commission Order Directing Filing. Ms. Weeden stated that she and Laclede have resolved their dispute. Consequently, she asks that the Commission accept her notice of dismissal.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a party may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral

evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of the dismissal. This case may be closed.
