1. Representatives of AGP have made a cursory review of Aquila's filing and the Staff Recommendation.

2. Based on that limited review, we have not at this time found mathematical errors that would suggest rejection of the proposed tariff.

3. However, AGP respectfully reserves its right to assert a position regarding the filing at a later date including without limitation challenge of the amount of hedging costs that

are proposed in the filing and the prudence of the activities
fuel procurement activities that are the subject of the filing.
Accordingly, if approved, the tariff should only be approved
subject to refund.


