# Title 4-DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT Division 240 – Public Service Commission Chapter 3 – Filing and Reporting Requirements

### ORDER OF RULEMAKING



By the authority vested in the Public Service Commission under Section 386.250, RSMo. 2000, the Public Service Commission amends a rule as follows:

4 CSR 240-3.530 Filing Requirements for Telecommunications Company Applications for Authority to Issue Stock, Bonds, Notes and Other Evidences of Indebtedness is amended.

A notice of proposed rulemaking containing the text of the proposed amendment was published in the *Missouri Register* on May 3, 2004 (29 MoReg 724). No changes have been made in the text of the proposed amendment, so it is not reprinted here. This proposed amendment becomes effective thirty (30) days after publication in the *Code of State Regulations*.

SUMMARY OF COMMENTS: The written public comment period ended June 2, 2004, and the commission held a public hearing on this proposed rule on June 4, 2004. Natelle Dietrich on behalf of the commission's staff filed comments and testified at the public hearing in support of the proposed amendment. Mimi MacDonald, counsel for Southwestern Bell Telephone, LP d/b/a SBC Missouri, filed written comments and testified at the public hearing in this proceeding but made no specific comments directed to this proposed rule amendment. Michael Dandino of the Office of the Public Counsel testified at the public hearing, generally in support of the proposed rule.

RESPONSE: No change to this section will be made as a result of the general comments.
