ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

On February 14, 2008,¹ the Commission issued its final Report and Order in this matter bearing an effective date of February 24. In ordered paragraph 8 of that order, the Commission directed Missouri Gas Energy (“MGE”) and The Empire District Gas Company to file revised tariff sheets identifying which types of certificates they have (i.e. transport, line, or service area certificates) in all of the areas in which they hold any type of certificate to provide any type of natural gas service. The Commission set a deadline of May 26 for the filing of the revised tariff sheets.²

On May 20, in its attempt to comply with the Commission’s order, MGE submitted proposed revisions to its P.S.C. MO. No. 1, tariff sheets. The filing was assigned Tariff Tracking No. YG-2008-0691 and the revised tariff sheets bear an effective date of June 20. Consequently, the Commission will direct its Staff to review the revised tariff sheets and file a

report and recommendation as to whether MGE is now in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order with regard to revising its tariff sheets.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than June 9, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report and recommendation regarding Missouri Gas Energy's compliance filing stating whether Missouri Gas Energy is in compliance with the portion of the Commission's February 14, 2008 Report and Order requiring Missouri Gas Energy to revise its tariff sheets identifying which types of certificates they have in all of the areas in which they hold any type of certificate to provide any type of natural gas service.

2. This order shall become effective on May 21, 2008.
